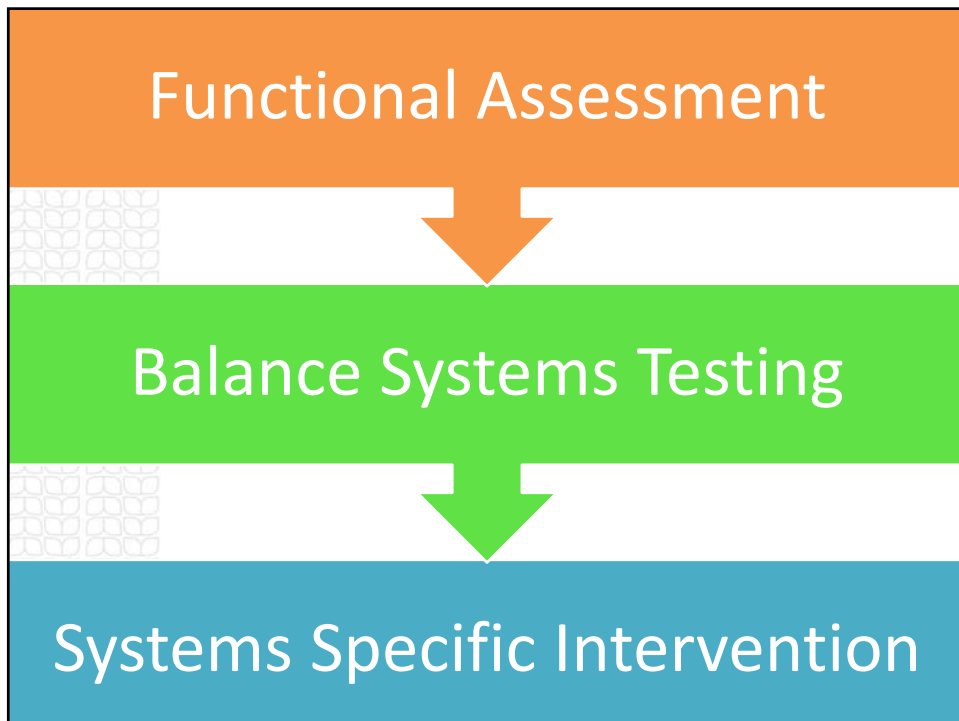


Functional Movement Evaluation

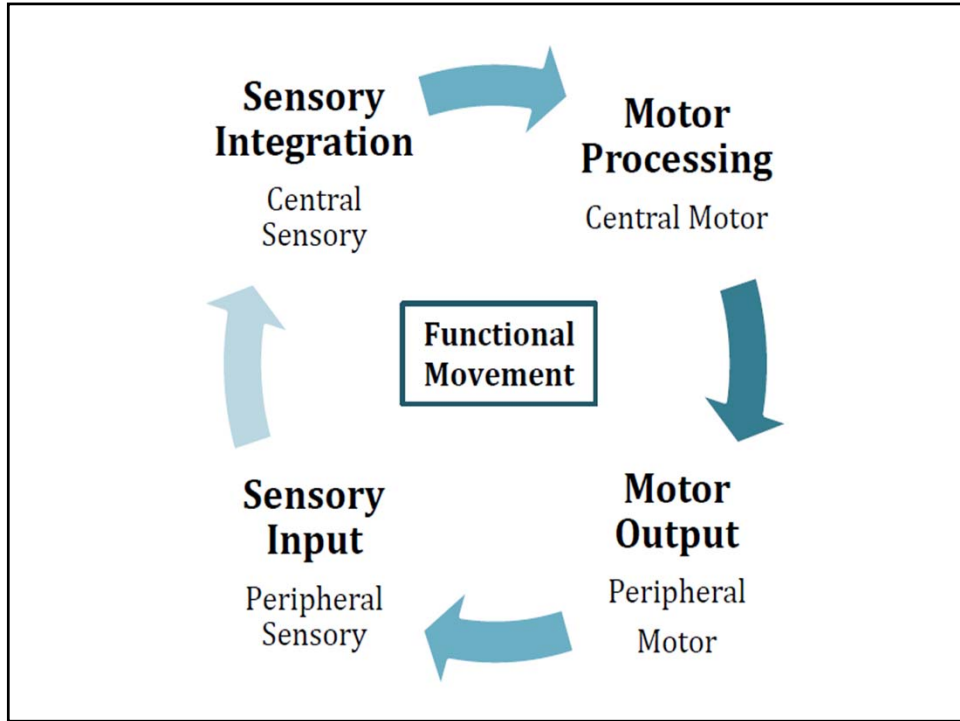
- Assesses Functional Mobility and ADLs/IADLs

 - ✓ *And “Is the patient a fall risk?”*

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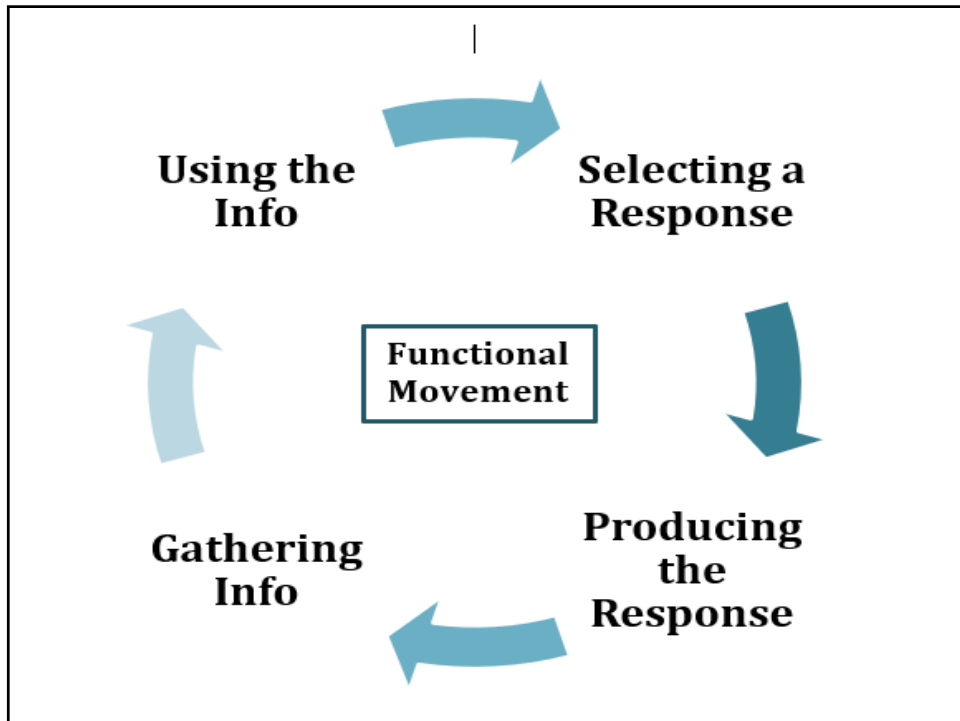
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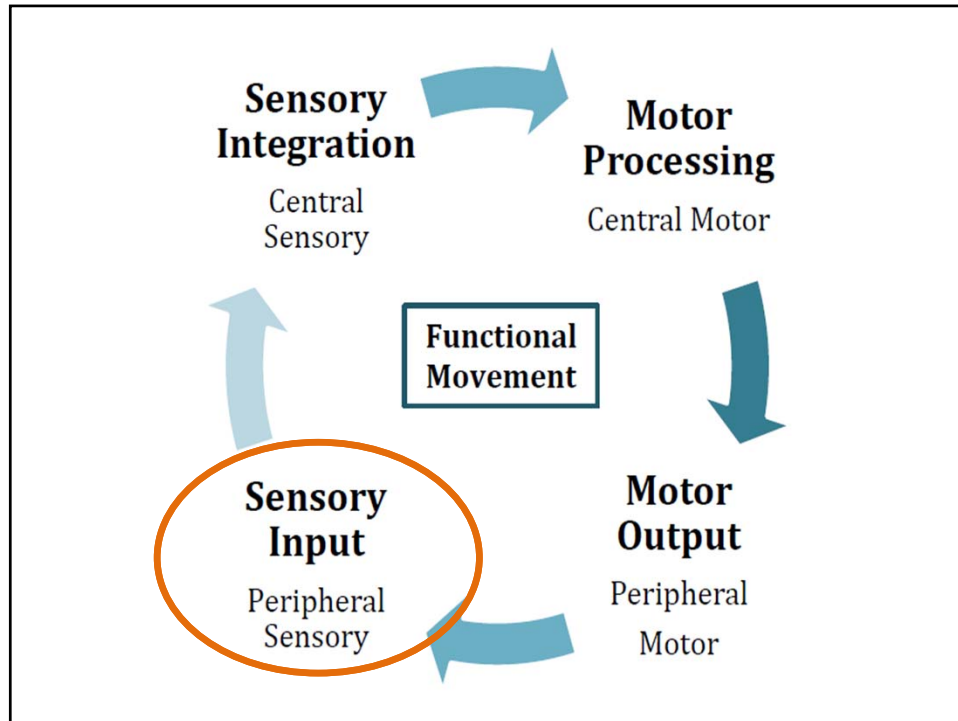

- **Vestibular**

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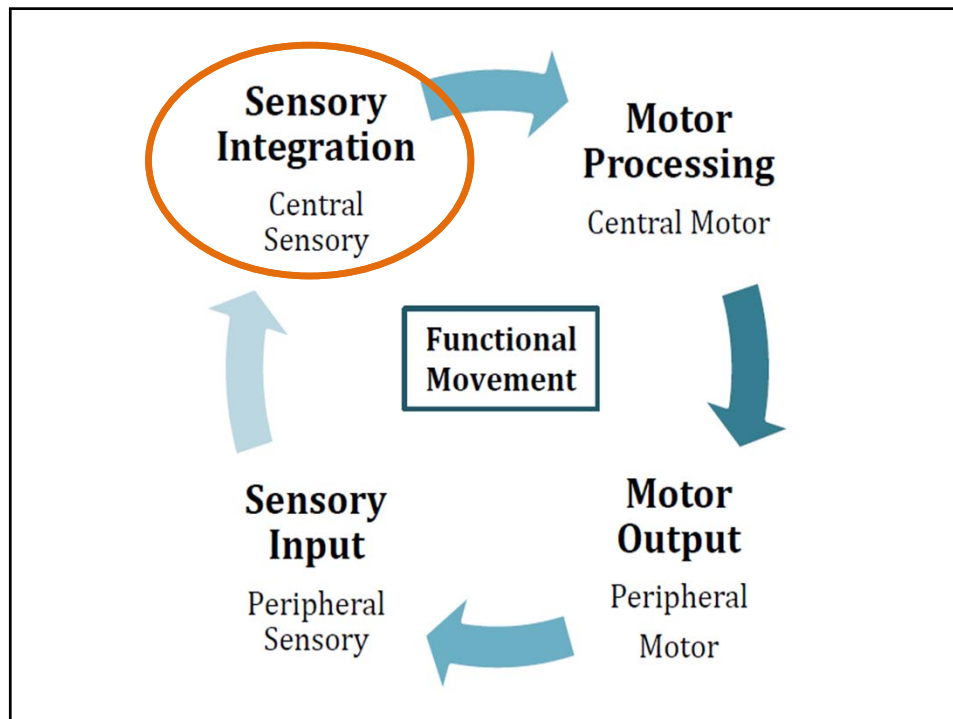

Where Are the Greatest Risks?


- **Presence of a medical condition that affects or limits one of these inputs**
 - Vision (i.e., glaucoma, cataracts)
 - Somatosensation (i.e., neuropathy)
 - Vestibular (i.e. hypofunction, vertigo, BPPV)

- **Presence of an environment or situation that affects or limits one of these inputs**

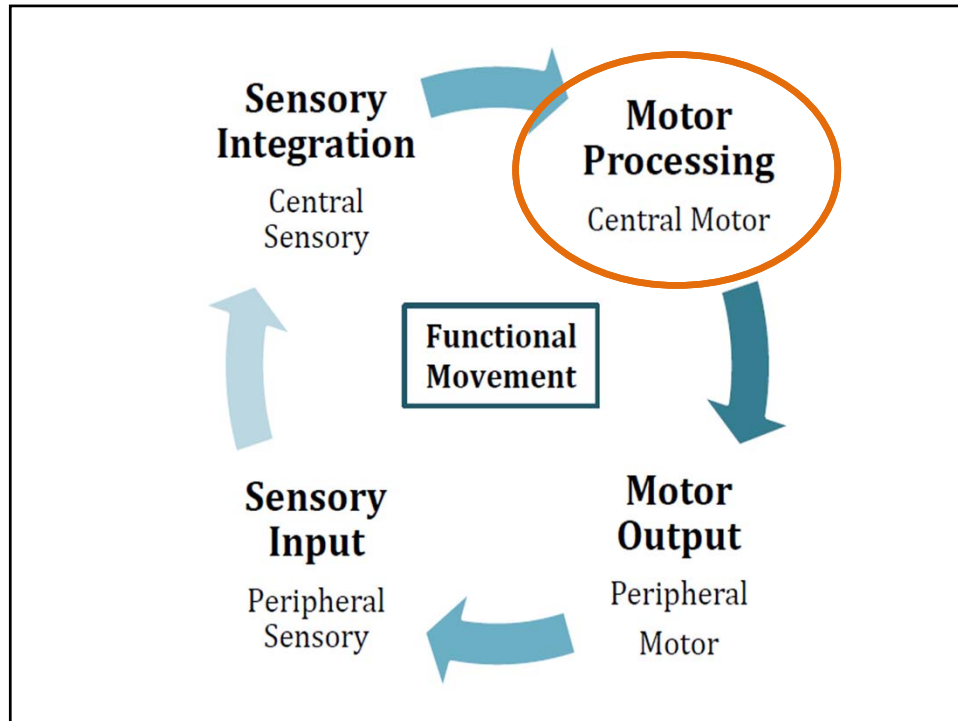


Where Are the Greatest Risks?

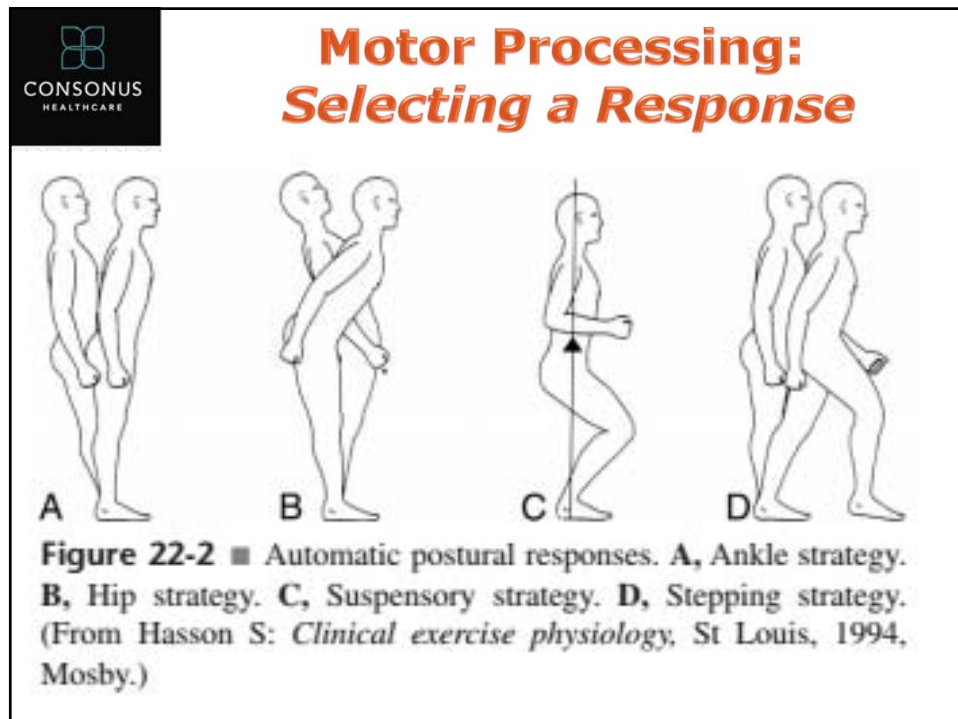
- **Dependence on Visual Processing**
 - Difficulty in dark or busy/complex environments
- **Dependence on Somatosensation Processing**
 - Difficulty on uneven surfaces/varied terrains or with footwear changes
- **Hypo-Vestibular Processing**
 - Difficulty in situations where both visual and somatosensory inputs are challenged
 - Difficulty with changes in speed and head-on-body positions

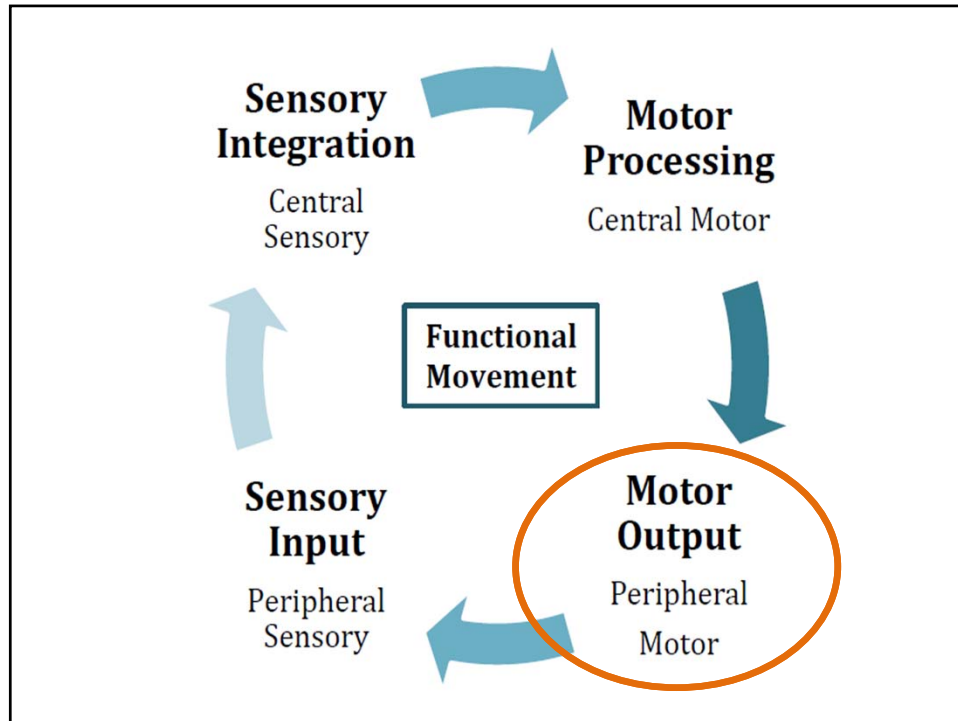


Where Are the Greatest Risks?

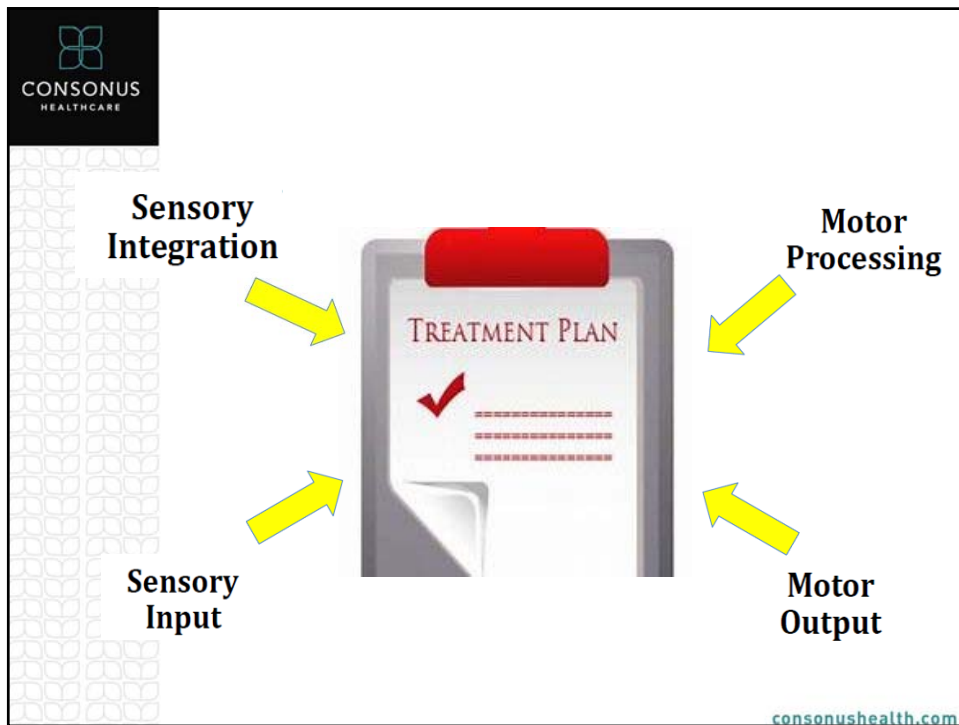

- Presence of a medical condition that affects reaction time, strength/power, coordination, and/or range of motion

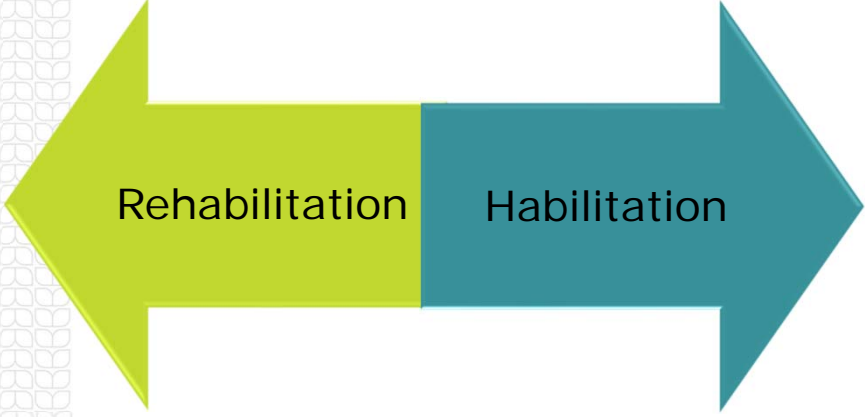

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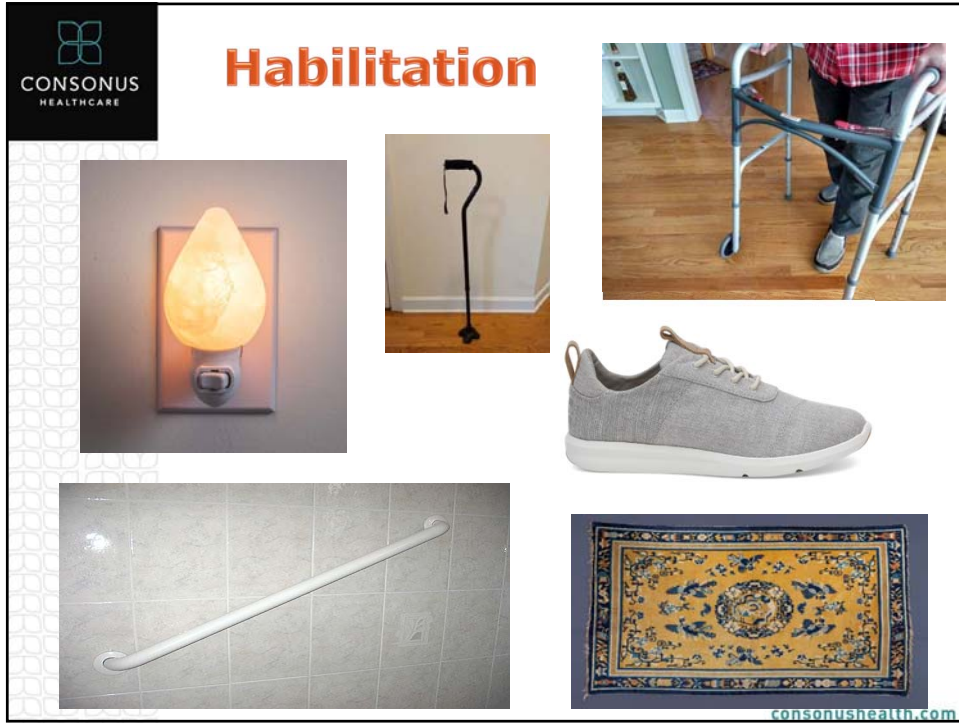

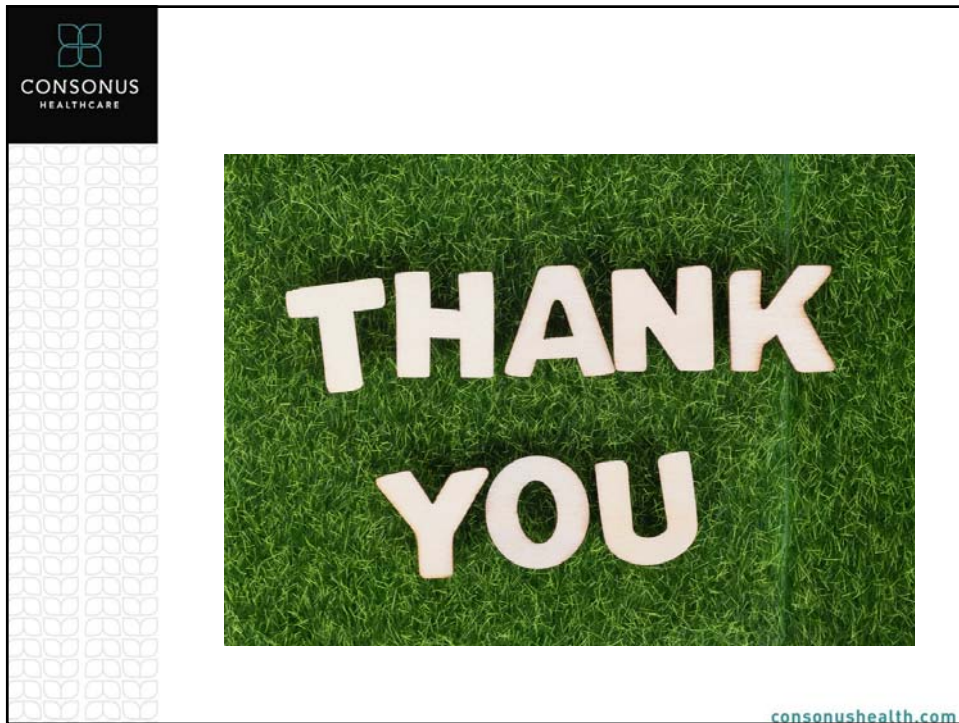
